POSSIBLE POINTS OF ACTION

This meeting does not have to make any decisions, however, the following are items that might be decided:

1. That we call on City Hall to cancel the current Rent Review and to recommence it in a respectful manner.
2. That we call on City Hall to publically declare that the Rent Review forms as they currently exist should not be signed – because of the Declaration they contain.
3. That we contact and call on all members of City Council to take the decisions of this meeting for emergency debate at their scheduled meeting next Monday 22nd June.
4. That a protest be placed on City Hall at 5pm on Monday 22nd, to canvas members of City Council to defend the interests of tenants and support the above demands.
5. That this meeting agrees to the creation of a **Tenants Rights Association**, as a non-Party political organisation to assert and defend the people's rights and to liaise with City Hall or any others in this regards. Volunteers should be taken from each community and further public meetings and discussion arranged.
